


Neighborhood Legal Services Association Timeline

Incorporation of NLSA

- LSC Act
- Title XX of the Social Security Act
- First Area Agency on Aging Contract
- LSC Funding at 400 million
- 1982 ICRAW formed
- Legal Aid Society Child Advocacy Unit hires its first employee
- Legal Aid Society establishes its own board
- 1987 NLSA moves into 928 Penn Avenue Building
- Equal Justice Campaign initiated
- IOLTA established by the Pennsylvania Legislature
- PFA Pro Bono Program Started
- Violence Against Women Act Passed
- Contract for America calls for LSC restrictions and results in the creation of the Community Justice Project to provide capacity
- 1997 Southwestern Pennsylvania Legal Services Consortium established
- Creation of the Pittsburgh Pro Bono Partnership
- Establishment of NLSA Helpline/ Hotline
- Access To Justice Act Established
- Creation of Older & Wiser Program
- Lawyers on Loan Project
- Public Benefits Project
- Employment Law Project
- Medical Legal Collaborative Initiated
- Part-Time Pro Bono Coordinator hired
- Elimination of Restriction on Seeking Attorneys' Fees
